Entrance assessment and interview

Our entrance assessments for 10+, 11+ and 13+ candidates will comprise of both a computer-based and a guided written paper.

The computer-based assessment, constructed by Quest, will cover the following areas over a period of 70 minutes:

- Mathematics (30)
- English (20)
- Non-Verbal Reasoning (10)
- Verbal Reasoning (10)

These sections will be largely multiple choice and will not require typing or keyboard skills. Please note that, except for the English element, the assessment will adapt in difficulty dependent on the answers provided.

The guided written paper is 30 minutes long and will require students to formulate a personal response to a range of prompts.

It is important to us that all our potential pupils are comfortable, confident, and able to do their best when they come to our exam days so we would recommend that applicants familiarise themselves with the style of computer assessment before the exam day.
