Interviews

Candidates who have performed well enough in the examinations will be invited back for interview. The interviews are a chance for us to get to know you, to discuss your ambitions, your interests, your engagement with the wider world, and what you hope to gain from studying here: we are looking to identify students who will flourish at Trinity and make the most of our academic provision whilst making a meaningful contribution to the community. Our interview day will take place on Saturday 21 November between 8.30am - 2.00pm.

Most candidates will have two interviews: a 'general interview', which provides an opportunity for them to talk about themselves, what they hope to get from Sixth Form, and what motivates and excites them, and a 'critical engagement' interview which will give them an experience of what it is like to learn in our Sixth Form and talk more broadly about their academic interests. There will be some short pre-reading material for the critical engagement interview and this will be provided the week before the interview

Subject specific information

If a student has chosen Art, Drama, DT, Music or Photography they will have an additional subject interview in each of these subjects. These interviews are designed to test their aptitude for A Level study and may involve discussion of their GCSE work, alongside some unfamiliar material.
